We live in an age of information!

If you want to download an electronic copy or print out your home's blueprints or any of the other things listed below, you can find them on our county's website by visiting their building department. If you do a Google search for <u>Hillsborough County</u> <u>building department</u>, the first thing that comes up (came up for me) is, "Hillsborough County - Permits & Records"

After clicking on that link, you will go to a county screen with 17 red boxes to choose from. By clicking on "PLANS & PERMITS INFO (PGM STORE)" you will be taken to another page with a red box that says, "ENTER THE PGM STORE".

Please note, this store has nothing but **FREE** information. All you need to know is that the User ID is "<u>public</u>" and the Password is "<u>public</u>", which are both printed out right above the red box.


After clicking on the red box you will go to the log-in screen of Hillsborough County's Optix Web Workstation. Enter "<u>public</u>" into both boxes and after you log in, click on "<u>Document Repository</u>" and then click on the "<u>Query</u>" box. From the next screen you can enter any address and hit the "<u>Query</u>" box again to get things like:

- Permit applications
- Permit receipts
- Tree requirements for each lot
- AC certification papers
- Termite certificate
- Plans (blueprints)
- Survey
- · Irrigation plans and certificates
- Occupancy permit

If you want to go beyond just looking at your home's records or that of your neighbors, the attached sheet has the addresses that were used by Minto for Verona's swimming pool, bathhouse, gates, signs, mailbox kiosk, etc.




